

# Oversize or Extra-Legal Vehicles

## **Need to know**

Weight displacement is a major factor E-470 considers largely due to the length of some of its bridges. E-470 evaluates weight displacement upon the vehicles axles.

The E-470 Public Highway Authority (the "Authority") enforces truck weight and length policies and regulations with respect to motor carrier safety on interstate highways, in accordance with C.R.S. 42-4-510. Permits for excess size and weight and for manufactured home - rules. (II).
